Art & Craft Exhibition – Friday 19 to Saturday 20 October

Members are invited to exhibit up to six pieces of art or craft: paintings, drawings, sculpture, ceramics, textiles, woodcraft etc. Works may be for sale or labelled NFS.

Handing in at Riddell Hall: Thursday 18 October before or after the meeting

Collection of unsold works: Saturday 20 October 4pm - 5pm

Labelling: Each piece should have a white card label 8cm x 4cm loosely attached, written in capitals or typed in 18pt. In the exhibition these labels will be fixed to the front of the work or adjacent to them. Framed works should have cord or wire across the back for hanging and it would be helpful if artists would also have their names fixed or written on the reverse of their works in case labels and works become separated. Formats for the exhibition labels for framed and unframed works are shown below. For non framed works, a description followed by the maker and the price or NFS will be sufficient.
